



# Multi-Engine Rating

## General Requirements

1. Hold at least a private pilot certificate with a single-engine rating.\*
2. Hold at least a third-class medical certificate.
3. Pass the practical test.

\* *This rating may be pursued concurrently with a private pilot certificate.*

## Flight Requirements

There are no specific hourly requirements that the applicant must meet for the rating. An average student for the multi-engine rating requires between 10 and 15 hours of flight instruction. However, the instructional requirements vary from student to student depending on the experience level and flying skills.
